Kindly provide the information regarding the following

1 That as per directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to the Ministry of Home Affairs regarding the dowry cases and Ministry of Home issued directions to the National Crime Bureau and National Crime Bureau has prepared a report dowry cases on the instructions of the Hon'ble Court. In the report bureau informed that there were 9,68,728 cases have been registered between 2003 to 31.3.2013 out of which 17542 cases were found fit for prosecution. The National Crime Report Bureau on the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court have prepared a report which is very much astonishing. According to the report since the year 2003 to 31.3.2013 there were 9,68,728 cases were registered out of which 17542 cases were found fit for prosecution which is the only 1/8 percent of the dowry cases , however, 98.2 per cent were found fake.

That the Ministry of Home has issued the directions in this regard to all the States on 5.3.2015, and it is believed due to the aforesaid direction the cases under Section 498-A IPC shall be lesser.

2. Discussing by Sh. Ashok Bhasin has sent his suggesting

issued directions that the IO in the case of Dowry cases, cannot arrest the whole family members/ or relations on the statement of dowry victim.

Therefore you are requested to provide the **report prepared and submitted by the National Crime Report Bureau before the Hon'ble Supreme court.** According to the report since the year 2003 to 31.3.2013 there were 9,68,728 cases were registered out of which 17542 cases were found fit for prosecution which is the only 1/8 percent of the dowry cases , however, 98.2 per cent were found fake.
