Kindly provide the information regarding the following

4. Copies of the 10 questions as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme by IO of CAW Cell, Distt East, near Fazalpur Mandwali, Patparganj, New Delhi 110051 from the Complainant, Smt. Reshma Choudhary d/o late Mohd. Illyas R/o 27/26, Parwana Road, Radhey Shyam Park, Delhi 110051 against the her husband Rajab Ali Khan and in- laws.
5. That as per directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to the Ministry of Home Affairs regarding the dowry cases and Ministry of Home issued directions to the National Crime Bureau and National Crime Bureau has prepared a report dowry cases on the instructions of the Hon'ble Court. In the report bureau informed that there were 9,68,728 cases have been registered between 2003 to 31.3.2013 out of which 17542 cases were found fit for prosecution on the accused which is ratio of 1/8 are true and remaining 98.2 per cent matters were found forged.

However, prior to the present FIR No. 336/2015 dated 1.6.2015 the case of defamation was pending in the High Court and orders were passed by Hon'ble Ms. Justice Heme Kohli, dt. 25.5.2015 the copy of served, and complaint u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. was pending before the Trial Court, Karkardooma, Delhi. But no action was taken by the DCP and IO and have ignored the aforesaid complaint and case before the Hon'ble High.

Whether the IO has followed the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, and directions dated 2.7.2016. In this manner the DCP has violated the directions of the Supreme court and has committed the contempt of court. Supply the copy of 10 questions under the supervision of DCP.

Therefore the concerned police officers are liable to be punished under the Contempt of court Act and take action against the complainant, Mrs. Reshma Choudhary and her associates

Whether the action has been taken against them or not.

6. The case of Arnish Kumar Vs. State of Bihar dated 2.7.2014 to the IO that in the dowry cases first of all the IO shall ask 10 question from the victim woman if the questions are found fit, then IO shall submit his report to the District Magistrate thereafter shall obtain the permission and shall proceed further.


Whether the DCP and IO has considered the complaint of Reshma Choudhary a true complaint. To Prove the same.

If the dowry complaint is found forged in that even a fine of Rs. 1,000/- to 15,000/- shall be imposed and her name shall be entered in the list of forge person and shall be prosecuted accordingly.

The Raj Sabha has invited the suggestion from the Public at large for the amendment in the order. Thereafter Social worker Sh. Ashok Bhasin has sent his suggestion on 17.2.2015 referring the Supreme Court. Thereafter reply was sent on 10.4.2016 informing that the amendment has been done in the law.

That 5.3.2015 the Ministry Home has circulated this orders and thereafter Lok Sabha dated 10.4.2015 to all the States.
