Sub :- Implementation for Elimination of Child Labour.

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that in Garo Hills, Meghalaya a good deal of Casual/Workers are working under the contractors in the coal field/coal mine the number of such employees will be about one lakhs, the employees have not been provided proper facilities and education benefit, social religious, unemployment, sickness, old age, funeral etc. by the organization as well as contractors.

Now, we are very much willing to cover the child employees under Elimination of Child Labour and appeal the Govt. of Meghalaya Education Department to contribution in the National Programme for education of all children of the Labour and we are very happy in anticipation and fully or particularly rely or sub-section (2) of Act No.38 of 1964 as well as sub-section (1) of the Act, 42 of 1960 detailing making of the fund under the Trade Union Act, 1926. I am directed to send herewith the copy of Labour inspector Letter which is self-explanatory and to request you kindly to fix the rate of Rs.200/- per truck for use of Labour/Member of the Association which will go to the union fund. Our labourers are at present working under the so called coal dealers, Truck Owners & Drivers. So above parties are to be paid for our Labourers along with the contribution fees wages compensation as fixed by Govt. of Meghalaya under the Minimum wages Act 1948.

You are therefore, fervently requested to fix the rate for the benefit of our member of Labour Association in Consultation with the labour Department, Meghalaya, Shillong for the children of the Coal Worker and Governor of Meghalaya from the Shillong Times Tura on Saturday 22nd march, 2003 is provided herewith for your kind reference.

Now, under section 14(1) and (2) of the said Act Child Labour will be eliminated under this Act, so it may be confirmed to our office whether this large number of employees be covered under your Department by supervising/fixing the said section mentioned above.

It is also informed you that we have been trying to implementation the scheme from so many years with the Education Department, Shillong.

We are awaited for your kind approval, reply and necessary action please.
