
Sir,

Sub: Praying for a judicial reply from the core of your kind heart from a poor casual labour along with other 38 nos. of casual labours working under a biggest organization i.e. Indian Railways.

Reverend Sir,

At first excuse me for encroaching your precious time, Sir, I am Sri Sunil Kumar Sen, a poor casual labour. I, on behalf of my other 38 nos. of casual labours who are my colleagues have been working under S.E.Rly, Kharagpur Administration since long years (Approx 30 yrs.) Instead of our sincere work under S.E.Rly/KGP Divn. Rly. Authority has paid our payment by which we have only met two squares of meal and as such we are surviving with our family members and Rly. Administration has offered us good performance certificate for our sincere work in S.E.Rly/KGP Divn. and we have been verbally given assurance that in future we may be appointed as permanent Rly. employee as and when by the then Rly. Administrative officers under whom we have performed our job.

Sir, we have performed our works under SSE/PW/KGP, SSE/TT/MECH/KGP, SE/BRI/I/KGP, SE/BRI/II/KGP, SSE/RRI/signal/KGP, SSE/Elect/south/KGP, SSE/Elect/TRD/KGP etc. since 30 yrs. but the said Rly. Authority has not yet processed our case for regularization.

Sir, regarding this regularization of our case we have written a lot of letters to Rly. Administrative Ministers, Hon'ble Lalu Yadav, Miss Mamata Banerjee and others Rly. Higher Authority, Rly. Board's Chairman and other also. Under RTI ACT 2005 we have written to know the status of our raised questions to Regional Labour Commissioner/KGP, The Chief Labour Commissioner/Appellate authority who deal the labour problems. Sir, we are identified as Casual labours under Rly. Administration not Contractor labour. All the enclosed documents will speak itself. From any corner of any Administrative official have not yet received any hopeful reply also. Sir, we have spent our half of the life for the Rly. Administrative job as casual labour. It reveals that indirectly we are Rly. workers as and when in the field of loading and unloading job and another required job as and when we have been used for Rly. works.

Sir, now we are on the verge of middle age. We have no future in front of us. Being hopeless we are praying to you for passing necessary instruction to Rly. Administration for regularize us in Rly. Department as a Group 'D' staff for which we shall remain ever grateful to you. You are awaiting for a sentence from your end.
