**ORDER**

This relates to the appeal dated 17.11.2023 filed by Shri P.L. Banga (hereinafter referred to as the 'appellant') aggrieved with the reply provided by the CPIO.

2. The records are called for and it is observed that the appellant, vide his RTI application dated 19.10.2023, had sought information related to process of getting appointment to meet the President of IIPA, contact details of the officials of this Secretariat (including mobile numbers) and letters sent by the IIPA to this Secretariat. In reply, the CPIO, vide his letter dated 09.11.2023, provided point-wise information to the appellant.

3. In view of the grievance raised by the appellant on the reply provided by the CPIO, the following observations emerge:


(a) The provisions under the RTI Act, 2005 do not provide any prescribed format to provide information to the applicant by the CPIO. Hence, the CPIO is not bound to provide the reply to RTI applications only in a tabular form.

(b) In respect of the request of the appellant for receipt for the amount paid through IPO, it is to clarify that since the prescribed amount of Rs. 10/- had not been received by way of cash, there is no provision of providing receipt against the payment made other than cash.

(c) Vide point no. 3, the appellant in his RTI application had requested to intimate him letters sent to the office of Hon'ble Vice-President regarding IIPA as no reply was received by him. The appellant had not provided the details of the letter(s) on which he sought the information. As such, the reply provided by the CPIO on this point is in proper order.

(d) The appellant has contended that points no. 1 & 2 in his RTI application have not been properly replied. In this regard, reference is invited to Order issued by Hon'ble CIC in the matter of Shri K. Lall vs. Shri M. K. Bagri (Decision dated April 12, 2007), File No.CIC/AT/A/2007/00112, which held that "once information is placed on a website or in the public domain accessible to the citizens, that information cannot be said to be 'held' or 'under the control of' the public authority and thus ceases to be an information accessible under the RTI Act." No additional information is held in this Secretariat to provide in this regard.

4. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of without any further action.

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




Subject : Notice Under Rule 19 of MOA for AGM to be held on. 31/10/23
